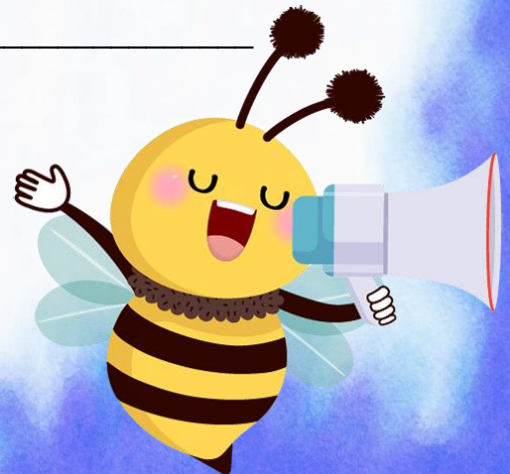

## Busy Bee Supply List

- Kleenex
- 2 rolls of Paper towels (select-a-size work best for little hands)
- Diaper wipes (We use diaper wipes daily for bottoms, hands (sometimes feet) and of course sweet faces)
- 1 box of fruit snacks
- 1 bag Goldfish crackers, pretzels or Ritz Bits Cheese type crackers

BOYS please provide the following items ~

- 1 box of zip lock style sandwich bags
- 1 package of LARGE uncoated paper plates
- Febreze Air Freshener
- Lysol Disinfectant Spray
- 1 ream of white paper

GIRLS please provide the following items ~

- 1 box of zip lock style gallon bags
- 1 package of SMALL uncoated paper plates
- 1 bottle of Clorox Free & Clear spray (or any disinfectant)
- Lysol/Clorox wipes
- 1 package of colored cardstock
