(<https://www.facebook.com/groups/238247071544010>) and requires you to answer one question.

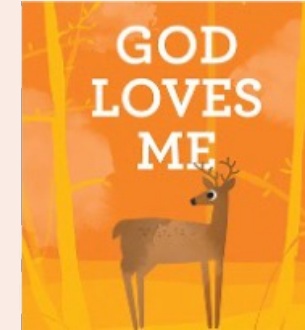


NOTE: in-house we are doing a redesign and update of our MAPP: app (Mobile Apps Portal for Parents)

Scholarships for Florida Schoolchildren

Did you know with the help of a Step Up For Students Scholarship, you could send your child to a private school near you?



Scholarships for K-12 Students to Attend Private School

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO) and the Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship Program offer scholarships worth on average \$8,000 and cover the cost of private school tuition and fees; tutoring, books and more.

Who is eligible?

- All K-12* students, regardless of household income, who are residents of Florida are eligible

Who has priority?

Priority will be given to families who meet the following criteria:

- Students whose household income is at or below 400% of the federal poverty level. For example, a family of four could have an income of up to \$120,000 annually and receive priority.
- Students currently in foster or out-of-home care
- Homeless children

* Students entering kindergarten must be 5 on or before September 1



Scholarships for Students with Unique Abilities

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA) is worth an average of \$10,400 and covers the cost of private school tuition, pre-K tuition, instructional materials, home education, tutoring and more.

Who is eligible?

- Students 3 years old to high school graduation or age 22, whichever comes first
- Children with one of 23 diagnoses including, but not limited to: autism spectrum disorder, Down syndrome, spina bifida and emotional, behavioral or intellectual disabilities
