This is my second year teaching at St. Paul’s. I have about 20 years of experience with children: babysitting/nannying, working in church nursery, tutoring, and teaching everything (preschool up to high school math) I’m excited to have your child in my class and meet our new parents as well! It is going to be a great year.

My vision of a preschool experience includes lots of play and lots of love for the two year olds. We will play in sand, water, and shaving cream. We will paint and make things with play dough. We will read books and sing songs everyday. We will learn colors, letters, numbers, and social skills through play. We eat snack each day; so, please pack a small lunch box and water bottle. Something simple like goldfish and/or fruit is perfect. Please label both of these with first/last names.

I realize that for most of the children this will be their first experience at school or away from family members. There may be tears (from them and you) but they will pass. Some may take longer than others and that is okay. We will work together to make the transition as smooth as possible. One way to help is to say goodbye at the door and let them come in alone at 8:30am. If they are upset and clingy, you may hand them to us. You can always text me to check in about them.
